(*1) "12-year curriculum in an educational institution abroad" refers to schools whose geographical location is outside Japan, which in principle are officially recognized as a regular educational program by the country's educational authority, and which confer to graduates the eligibility to apply to universities. Applicants from schools such as international schools or American schools (except those who satisfy Basic Conditions (2) to (6)) should consult with us at an early stage as the confirmation of their eligibility status may take time.

The period spent in schools whose geographical location is outside of Japan but whose curriculum is based on Japan's School Education Law will not be counted toward the period in which the applicant received education in an educational institution abroad.

(*2) Applicants who wish to apply in the capacity of a student who has completed or is expected to complete "an equivalent educational program designated by the Japanese Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology" must contact the YCCS Program Admissions Office about their eligibility before applying.
